Good afternoon,

On Sunday, November 3, 2019, the 49th running of the TCS New York City Marathon will be held across the five boroughs. The Health and Medical ESF would like to provide some event specific information for situational awareness or any planning/preparedness efforts you may have for Sunday.

Event Information

The NYC Marathon is the largest marathon event in the world and the signature event of the New York Road Runners (NYRR). Approximately 52,000 runners are estimated to take on the 26.2 mile course. The course (map attached) starts in Staten Island, takes runners through Brooklyn, up into Queens, before entering Manhattan. After a trip up into the Bronx, runners will head back down into Manhattan and enter Central Park to cross the finish line.

The event begins at 8:30AM with the Wheelchair Divisions, and is followed by Wave 1 at 9:40AM – see attached for a full start timeline. The event is expected to conclude around 7:30PM.

The course will be completely closed to vehicular traffic during the race. A list of street closures and approximate times are available at this <u>link</u>.

Medical Coverage

According to NYRR estimates, there will be approximately 5,600 individual medical visits to the race medical facilities along the route and between 20-25 hospital transports by EMS.

NYRR handles this medical case volume with 54 privately contracted ambulances (Senior Care) and 38 medical tents located along the route.

FDNY has created an Incident Action Plan (IAP) for the event and will have pre-deployed resources along the route.

Utilizing RFI Chip Technology and historical data from runner identification bibs, NYRR can track the concentration of runners along the route, which will be utilized to assist in resource allocations.

Healthcare facilities and partner agencies located in the vicinity of the course are asked to notify appropriate staff and review emergency plans.

NYCEM Actions

To facilitate situational awareness and interagency coordination, NYCEM will deploy staff to the following:

- NYCEM's Interagency Command Center (ICC) will be located near the finish line
- NYRR Race Communications Center
- NYPD Joint Operation Center (JOC)

Additionally, NYCEM response personnel will be deployed on either side of the route to speed our responses

if needed.

NYCEM's Watch Command will be monitoring the event and will be able to notify hospitals of major incidents (10-60's) or MCI's via the emergency radio frequencies.
